

XSITE LAN Party Code of Conduct

I want to participate in the XSITE LAN Party on the 4 – 5th February 2012. My signature (and that of my parent/guardian if I am under the age of 18) on this document is my agreement to follow these rules, and I understand that I may be ejected from the event for violations of these rules or for other offenses that may not be included on this list.

1. From 12 – 7am Sunday the 5th, this is a “Lock In” event. If I leave the building before 7am I will not be able to access my computer or other items that I left in the building until the doors unlock at 7am – medical and extenuating circumstances allowed of course – Cody Smith / Brett Young will advise in these cases.
2. I understand that I will not access the computer of any other participant. This includes electronic connection or physical contact. Exceptions will only take place with owner’s permission.
3. I will not share nor distribute any files other than those certified by the LAN Leader.
4. I will respect my fellow LANers, the LAN equipment, the organisers and all XSITE equipment.
5. My screen saver and background wallpaper will not be overtly pornographic or sexually explicit or demeaning. If in doubt ask the LAN Leader.
6. My computer has an up to date antivirus program installed and I believe that my system is free of viruses and malware.
7. I will only plug into the power and network locations that are designated for my use.
8. I will not attempt to access any portions of the server, router, or network that are not specifically designated as being open for my use.
9. While losing sucks and can be a tad annoying, I will refrain from petulant outbursts and demonstrations of anger – i.e. Don’t be a twit if you lose!
10. I will **NOT** bring alcohol or any illegal substances to the XSITE centre or surrounds.
11. I will not bring any lethal weapons, including toys or replica weapons to the event.
12. I understand that computer speakers are disruptive and that my computer speakers are not to be used at this event – bring headphones!
13. I will not access any harmful, sexual, or pornographic websites while on event provided internet access.
14. If I accidentally or deliberately damage any of the artwork at XSITE, I will be responsible for reimbursing the artist for their work.
15. If I spill a drink or food, clean it up immediately, ask the LAN leader for assistance.
16. If I damage any equipment, furniture or infrastructure at XSITE, I am responsible for reimbursing Exergaming Australia Pty Ltd – hey, accidents happen, and that’s cool, but if you unduly damage anything at XSITE you must pay for replacement!
17. I may bring prescription medication to the event if it has my name on the label and has not expired - if in doubt check with the LAN Leader.
18. I will bring some Anti-Perspirant should I be known to ‘ming’ at tad during long gaming sessions!
19. I’m here to game, have fun and enjoy time with likeminded souls!
